When is it? June 22-27, 2020

Where is it? The International Thespian Festival takes place on the beautiful campus of Indiana University Bloomington in southern Indiana. The driving distance from Middleton, WI to Bloomington, IN, is 389 miles. The total driving time is 6 hours, 11 minutes.

Who can attend? Current MHS Theatre students.

How much does it cost? The whole trip will cost between \$1000-\$1050 per student and includes everything...transportation, lodging, workshops, shows, meals, etc. A check for \$300 is due Jan. 28 to secure your place, followed by \$250 due by Feb. 28, \$250 due by March 28, and \$200-\$250 due by April 29 paid via FEE PAY. There will be scholarship assistance available for students, so please do not let cost be the factor you do not consider this opportunity. Please talk to Ms. Brunner if you are concerned about the financial aspect of this trip.

How do I reserve my spot? Submit the "Initial Registration Form" with your initial deposit of \$300 by January 28.
