**We're going to the International Thespian Festival this year!**  
**June 24-29, 2019**

**What is it?** Every summer, thousands of high school Thespians bring their love of all things theatre to the Thespian Festival, a celebration of student achievement in the performing arts. Organized by the Educational Theatre Association and hosted by the University of Nebraska in Lincoln, the Festival is a one-of-a-kind, weeklong immersion experience in singing, dancing, acting, designing, directing, creating, writing, and memory-making. Festival features workshops presented by theatre professionals, individual and group performances, programs for technical theatre students, and opportunities to audition for college admission and scholarship. Whether you're just beginning your theatrical journey, a seasoned senior with an impressive resume and great headshot, or an educator seeking enriching professional development -- the International Thespian Festival has something to offer you!

**Why do I want to go?** It's an opportunity to spend a week with theatre students from across the country (as well as your fellow MHS Theatre Company). You will get to attend workshops with theatre professionals, see incredible high school productions, and participate in a bunch of other theatre-related opportunities. Last year MHS students attended TheFest and had an incredible trip! They saw two (or more) shows a day, attended excellent workshops, and got to meet and spend time with theatre people from across the country. Talk to Theatre Officers if you have questions.

**When is it?** June 24-29, 2019 (return time TBD based on numbers).

**Where is it?** Lincoln, Nebraska on the campus of the University of Nebraska.

**Who can attend?** Current MHS Theatre students.

**How much does it cost?** The whole trip will cost \$950 per student and includes everything...transportation, lodging, workshops, shows, meals, etc. A check for \$250 is due Jan. 25 to secure your place, followed by \$250 due by Feb. 25, \$250 due by March 25, and \$200 due by April 29 paid via FEE PAY. There will be scholarship assistance available for students, so please do not let cost be the factor you do not consider this opportunity. Please talk to Ms. Brunner if you are concerned about the financial aspect of this trip.

**How do I reserve my spot?** Submit the "[Initial Registration Form](#)" with your initial deposit of \$250 by January 25.
