The 2023 Jerry Awards Show will be held on Sunday, June 11, 2023.

The show on June 11th is filled with incredible performances including Outstanding Musical award recipients, solos featuring the Outstanding Lead Performers, and group numbers showing off the talent of the Outstanding Supporting Performers, and Outstanding Dance Performers. - Spirit Award or Finale number or the Orchestra performance will receive ONE ticket for themselves
