2021 Modifications

We are planning to hold the 2021 festival in-person with an allowance for schools to submit entries to be adjudicated online. As of September 2021, there will be a requirement for COVID-19 vaccination/negative COVID test within 72 hours prior to arriving on the UW-Stevens Point, as well as a requirement for face covering/masks over nose and mouth at all times, except when performing on-stage. This may change by the festival. Additionally, in order to promote public health and safety, this year's in-person festival will be limited to one-act performances, with limited prerecorded workshops available for registered directors/teachers to access online and share with their students. Thespys will happen entirely online. Any school is welcome to bring students to one-act performances; those schools will gain access to pre-recorded workshops and contacts with post-secondary theatre programs.
